Contract Documents and the Contract Specifications

The Contract Specifications, Section 5-1.02, Control of Work – Contract Components, states:

5-1.02 CONTRACT COMPONENTS

A component in one Contract part applies as if appearing in each. The parts are complementary and describe and provide for a complete work.

If a discrepancy exists:

- 1. Governing ranking of Contract parts in descending order is:
 - 1.1 Special provisions
 - 1.2 Project plans
 - 1.3 Revised standard specifications
 - 1.4 Standard specifications
 - 1.5 Revised standard plans
 - 1.6 Standard plans
 - 1.7 Supplemental project information
- 2. Written numbers and notes on a drawing govern over graphics
- 3. Detail drawing governs over a general drawing
- 4. Specific specification governs over a general specification
- 5. Specification in section governs over a specification referenced by that section

If a discrepancy is found or confusion arises, submit an RFI.

When the Structure Construction technical manuals refer to the **Contract documents** and the **Contract Specifications**, the term:

- 1. **Contract documents** includes the contract components identified in *Contract Specifications*, Section 5-1.02, *Control of Work Contract Components*, shown above.
- 2. **Contract Specifications** include the:
 - 2.1 Special provisions
 - 2.2 Revised standard specifications
 - 2.3 Standard specifications
