Listed below, in accordance with the California Code of Regulations, Section 16431, Annual Report, is a summary of awarded contracts and enforcement activities for the California Department of Transportation Labor Compliance Program for fiscal year 2020/2021:

- 1087 contracts awarded with a value of \$4,340,605,045.19 were subject to prevailing wage requirements. These are construction, emergency, and service contracts with a value of more than \$25,000 for construction and more than \$15,000 for alteration, demolition, installation, repair, and maintenance. See Attachment 1.
- 10 contracts awarded with a value of \$171,186.19 were not subject to prevailing wage requirements. These are construction, emergency, and service contracts with a value of \$25,000 or less for construction, and \$15,000 or less for alteration, demolition, installation, repair, and maintenance. See Attachment 1.
- 7 labor compliance wage cases were processed, settled and closed, or withdrawn during this fiscal year. See Attachment 2.
- 105 prevailing wage violations involving 460 employees were resolved outside of the wage case process in the amount of \$738,502.03. See Attachment 3.
