Submission of Welding Reports (Hard Copies)

This letter is a follow up to the meeting held on March 29, 2010, between ABFJV and the Department (Team China) at which the postponement of the submittal of the hard copies of the Welding Reports was discussed.

The electronic data base established under the contract change order #77 is sufficiently developed and completed to assure compliance with the welding requirements of the contract Special Provisions, Section 8-3.01 Welding - Welding Quality Control. Because of the progress made in organizing all the welding information (data base) with all the backup weld reports on file and accessible to all parties, it is agreed to postpone the submittal to the Department of the hard copies of the Welding Reports. As such, the requirement as provided for in the "Welding Report that is to be submitted to the Engineer within 10 days following the performance of any welding" is here forth suspended. It is understood that after departure of each shipment the hard copies of the Welding Reports related to the shipped components will be provided and transported to Oakland on the subsequent voyage.

We look forward to continue working with the ABFJV to update the data base. Both Quality Control and Quality Assurance are working very well together. It has been a real pleasure to see the respective parties in China working so well together and in a cooperative way to successfully execute the SAS contract.
