Full Closures of North Interstate 5 Connector to East/West State Route 22, South I-5 at East State Route 91 and Various Ramps 09/18/16 to 09/23/16

Irvine – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will continue construction activity along the I-5 from Red Hill Avenue undercrossing to Orangethorpe Avenue overcrossing. North I-5 Connector to East and West SR-22; North I-5 On Ramp at 17th Street; North I-5 Off Ramp at South Broadway; South I-5 at East SR-91 and South I-5 to South Main Street Off Ramp will be closed from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. Detours will be posted to alert motorists. Crews will be applying methacrylate sealing to the structure and roadway.
