NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR ECHO SUMMIT SIDEHILL VIADUCT REPLACEMENT

WHAT IS PLANNED

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to replace the Echo Summit Sidehill Viaduct at PM 67.3 on U.S. Highway 50 in El Dorado County with a new single-span bridge. The project includes upgrading the existing guardrail to current standards, constructing concrete transition barriers from the new bridge rail to the upgraded guardrail, grinding the asphalt concrete at the bridge approaches and placing a smooth transition from the approaching roadway to the new deck. Pot holing, paving, and striping may be completed on a selected alternative route.

The environmental document, referred to as a Draft Initial Study (IS)/ Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration
