




# PUBLIC NOTICE

## NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR ROUNDABOUT PROJECT AT THE INTERSECTION OF U.S. HIGHWAY 50 AND STATE HIGHWAY 89

### WHAT IS PLANNED

The Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to make intersection improvements to the U.S Highway 50 and State Highway 89 intersection within the community of Meyers (postmile 70.62) in El Dorado County, by installing a 3-legged roundabout. The Initial Study/Proposed Negative Declaration is the Draft Environmental Document for the project in which Caltrans has studied the effects the project may have on the environment and determined the project will not significantly affect the quality of the environment.

The environment document, referred to as an initial study/proposed negative declaration, is available for review from October 5 until November 5, 2016, at the El Dorado County Library, 1000 Rufus Allen Blvd., South Lake Tahoe, 96150.
