U.S. 101 Santa Clara County Capital Maintenance Project

Santa Clara County—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin a maintenance project starting Wednesday, May 18 to grind existing concrete pavement and replace damaged concrete slabs on U.S. 101 in Morgan Hill and San Jose. This project proposes to replace all severely damaged broken concrete pavement slabs and resurface the existing asphalt concrete pavement on the mainline only. In addition, the project will also replace crash cushions, install metal beam guard rails and modify traffic loop detectors at various locations. All work should be completed by the end of October, 2016.

Work being performed Monday through Thursday nights will begin at 9:00 p.m. and will end at 5:00 a.m. the following day. Friday night work will end by 9:00 a.m. on Saturday. There will be various freeway lane and ramp closures during this project; however, **Caltrans will always provide at least one open lane in either direction of travel and never close two consecutive ramps.**

Noise will be inevitable during the concrete slab removal and replacement process; however, it will be kept within approved construction noise limits.

This project will provide an improved quality of ride for motorists and extend the service life of the existing pavement.

Advance warning changeable message signs and detour signs are in place to assist motorists traveling in the area. Motorists are advised to use caution when traveling through the area and please "Slow for the Cone Zone."
