U.S. Route 101 – Removing and Replacing Asphalt in Brisbane (Lane Closures Scheduled)

San Mateo County- The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin an emergency project to remove and replace failed sections of the roadway on U.S. Route 101 in the City of Brisbane between Candlestick Park and Oyster Point Boulevard. The new asphalt will improve the ride of the existing pavement and extend its service life. To ensure public and worker safety, the following lane closures have been scheduled.

Friday, July 8, 2016

Southbound Route 101, Between Candlestick Park and Sierra Point Parkway: Various lane closures. 11:00 PM to 6:00 AM.

Friday, July 15, 2016

Southbound Route 101, Between Sierra Point Parkway and Oyster Point Boulevard: Various lane closures: 11:00 PM to 6:00 AM.

Friday, July 22, 2016

Southbound Route 101, Between Candlestick Park and Oyster Point Parkway: Various lane closures: 11:00 PM to 6:00 AM.

Detour signs will be placed to help guide motorists through the construction zone.

NOTE: *At the beginning of the shift, Residents and Businesses may notice increased noise from grinding/paving equipment and mandatory backup alarms while working in the construction zone.*
