


Stage 4 of U. S. 101/Broadway Interchange Project



San Mateo County/Burlingame – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin stage 4 construction of the Route 101 Broadway Interchange project. Beginning Friday, October 7, at 8:00 P.M, **Bayshore Highway to northbound Route 101 through access will close to through traffic in order to construct new detours.**

During the evening of October 7, to the early morning hours of October 8, access will be limited to businesses only. During this time between the hours of 11:00 P.M. to 5:00 A.M, lanes 3 and 4 of northbound 101 and the northbound 101 Broadway exit, will be closed and detoured to Millbrae Avenue. **Changeable Message Signs will be in place 3 days prior to closing.**

Beginning on the morning of October 8, at 8:00 A. M. through traffic for Bayshore Highway to northbound Route 101 will be restored by way of detours. The above map shows the traffic configuration that will be in place from October 8, to the beginning of April 2017.

This stage will allow construction of the east approach to the Broadway overcrossing. This work is part of the 101 Broadway Interchange Reconstruction Project. The scheduled completion date is end of 2017 (weather permitting).
