I-780-Laurel Street Bridge in Vallejo Major Construction Completed Caltrans Anticipates Opening New Bridge to Traffic By Friday, January 12, 2018

SOLANO COUNTY – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has completed a major portion of construction of the new Interstate-780 (I-780) Laurel Street Bridge and is now anticipating opening the new bridge to traffic by Friday, January 12, 2018. This is weather dependent.

The bridge is located over I-780 just east of Downtown Vallejo.
