State Route 1 in Sonoma County at Gleason Beach Update for Construction Activities and Traffic Control

SONOMA COUNTY – Caltrans will remove temporary concrete barriers on Friday, September 2 because the rock slope protection activity has been completed. State Route 1 will be open for two lane traffic during the Labor Day Weekend. Portable signals will be turned off and folded down.

On September 6 portable traffic signals will be reactivated and the southbound lane will be closed while compaction grouting is completed. This work should be complete around September 16, weather permitting. This activity will be followed by paving on Saturday, September 17, at which point the highway will be reopened to two way traffic.

If work is delayed due to weather conditions, it will be rescheduled. Please drive cautiously through the construction zone, leave a safe traveling distance between your vehicle and the vehicle ahead of you, and Slow for the Cone Zone.
