Eastbound State Route-152 Pacheco Pass Highway in Hollister Fallen Rock Prevention Work Starts Tuesday, October 16, 2018

SANTA CLARA COUNTY– The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform rock wall scaling and slope cutting to mitigate rocks falling into travel way on westbound (EB) SR-152 at Pacheco Pass Highway, in the city of Hollister. One lane will be closed for crews to safely perform rope rappelling and rock scaling on EB mountainside of SR-152. Periodically, crews will shut down both WB and EB lanes for safety clearance as needed. Work is scheduled to begin October 16, and be complete October 18.

Schedule of work and lane Closure:

Tuesday, October 16, 2018	9:00 AM to 3:00 PM
Wednesday, October 17, 2018	9:00 AM to 3:00 PM
Thursday, October 18, 2018	9:00 AM to 3:00 PM

During this work, motorist may experience delays as crews scale the rock slope to perform prevention work. Lane closure signs will be posted. California Highway Patrol will be onsite during lane closure. All work is weather permitting.

Please drive cautiously through the construction zone, leave a safe traveling distance between your vehicle and the vehicle ahead of you, and please #BeWorkZoneAlert.
