## **Caltrans Bridge Rail Replacement Project in Los Gatos SR- 17 Full Freeway Closure**

**Santa Clara County-** The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is replacing bridge railings at two locations along State Route 9 at (Booker Creek on post mile 3.6 and Highway 9 at (State Route 17) at post mile 11.4. (See Map Below)

The work will involve the removal of bridge railings, metal beam guardrails, saw cutting sidewalk and grinding asphalt both during the day and evening. There will be ramp and freeway closures during this project. Noise is inevitable during this project; however, it will be kept within approved construction standards.

Advance warning changeable message signs will be in place to assist motorists traveling in the area. Motorists are advised to use caution when traveling through the area and please "Slow for the Cone Zone."

### **SR-17 Full Freeway Closures Friday (7/15) and Saturday (7/16):**


**Caltrans will alternate between closing the southbound SR-17 and northbound SR-17. Only one side will be closed at a time on both Friday 7/15 and Saturday 7/16 between the hours of 1:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m. Caltrans will start the full closure on southbound SR-17 at 1:00 a.m. on 7/15 Friday morning and shift to the northbound direction at approximately 3:00 a.m. on 7/15 Friday morning. The same sequence will occur on 7/16 Saturday morning from 1:00 a.m. to 5:00 a.m.**

**Southbound SR-17 Detour:** Off-ramp to WB Los Gatos / Saratoga Rd (SR-9) to SB N Santa Cruz Ave to SB 17

**Northbound SR-17 Detour:** Off-ramp to N Santa Cruz Ave to NB Winchester Blvd to EB Lark Ave to NB-17
