## **State Route 29 Between Napa and St. Helena Overnight One-Way Traffic Controls Paving Work Begins Monday, May 21, 2018-Fall 2018**

**NAPA COUNTY**— The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is scheduled to begin major roadway pavement work on State Route 29 (SR-29) in Napa County.

This is part of a long-term project to repair the pavement on State Route 29 (SR-29) between Napa and just south of St. Helena. Preliminary drainage work started in March 2018.

The valley temperatures are now warm enough for crews to begin paving 12-miles of SR-29 between north of Trancas Street in Napa and Mee Lane in the County of Napa.

### **Overnight Work Starts May 21, 2018**

Paving work starts Monday, May 21 until fall 2018. Work is scheduled Mondays-Fridays starting at 7:00 PM until 6:00 AM the following mornings. All work is weather permitting

### **No work is scheduled on the following holiday/regional event dates:**

- May 25-May 28, 2018.....Memorial Day/Bottle Rock
- July 2-July 8, 2018..... Independence Day
- August 31-September 3, 2018..... Labor Day/Harvest

### **One-Way Traffic Controls-Expect Delays**

To ensure worker and public safety, one-way traffic controls will be in effect during the work on SR-29. Crews will alternate lane closures in both northbound and southbound directions. Motorists should expect delays and allow for extra travel time.
