## State Route 29-Napa County Overnight Closures-Four Consecutive Nights Start Monday, October 3 at 11:30PM

**NAPA COUNTY** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform four consecutive nights of pavement repair work on northbound and southbound State Route 29 (SR-29) in Napa County starting Monday, October 3.

The work will occur on SR-29 between State Route 12 (SR-12) and the State Route 221 (SR-221) interchanges near the Napa County Airport. Crews will be repairing cracks and sealing the roadway in advance of winter driving conditions.

### SR-29 Overnight Closure Hours

To ensure worker and public safety, overnight closures of SR-29 will start each night Monday, October 3 until the night of Thursday, October 6 concluding the morning of Friday, October 7. On Monday, Tuesday and Thursday, the work will start at 11:30PM until 4:00AM the following mornings. On Wednesday, October, 5 work is 11:00PM until 4:30AM, Thursday, October 6.

**Monday, October 3**-Southbound SR-29 will be closed from the junction of Soscol Ferry Road and SR-221 to the junction of Airport Boulevard and SR-12/Jameson Canyon Road.

**Tuesday, October 4**-Southbound SR-29 from the junction of Airport Boulevard and SR-12/Jameson Canyon Road to South Kelly Road will be closed.

**Wednesday, October 5**-Northbound SR-29 will be closed from South Kelly Road to the junction of SR-12/Jameson Canyon Road and Airport Boulevard.

**Thursday, October 6**-Northbound SR-29 will be closed from the junction of SR-12/Jameson Canyon and Airport Boulevard to North Kelly Road.
