### **J-Mack Ferry Morning Closure for Cable Replacement Sunday, August 28, 2016 starting at 6:30 AM**

**SOLANO COUNTY** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will temporarily close the J-Mack Ferry in the Delta to replace the main underwater cable which the ferry runs on across Steamboat Slough between Ryer Island in Solano County and Sacramento County.

The J-Mack is scheduled to close starting Sunday, August 28 at 6:30 AM until 10:00 AM that same morning.

The J-Mack Ferry provides around the clock service on State Route 220.

During the closure, motorists are advised to use the Real McCoy Ferry, also known as the Cache Slough Ferry along State Route 84.
