State Route 13 Storm Damage Repair Project at Moraga Avenue Work Scheduled for Saturday, August 6

Oakland, Calif. – Caltrans anticipates conducting work for construction of the Storm Damage Repair Project on State Route 13 (SR-13) at Moraga Avenue, Alameda County on Saturday August 6. The project is located east of the on ramp shoulder of northbound SR-13 (NB SR-13). The purpose of the project is to repair the slope and prevent further slide damage to the hillside. The project includes constructing earth retaining structures with a replanting project to follow construction.

The work may require a ramp closure at the Moraga Avenue on ramp to SR-13 northbound. Work hours are anticipated to be as follows:

- **Saturday August 6 from 7:00 AM until 5:00 PM**

Other Saturday work may be scheduled in the future to facilitate completion of the project. Detour signs will be in place to redirect motorists towards alternate routes. Construction vehicle traffic and noise may be experienced in and near the construction area and Fernwood Drive.
