Lane and Ramp Closures on State Route 92 Eastbound in Hayward

March 9 – 11, 2018

HAYWARD, Alameda County – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will conduct paving on eastbound (EB) State Route 92 (SR-92) in Hayward from Clawiter Road to Hesperian Boulevard from March 9 through March 11, 2018.

Beginning Friday night, March 9, 2018, from 11:00 PM to Saturday morning, March 10, 2018, at 7:00 AM; lanes 1, 2, and 3 will be closed during this time.

Beginning Saturday night, March 10, 2018, from 11:00 PM to Sunday morning, March 11, 2018, at 9:00 AM; lanes 2, 3, and 4 along with the Industrial Boulevard on-ramp will be closed during this time. Traffic from the Industrial Boulevard on-ramp closure will be detoured to Hesperian Boulevard and then onto westbound SR-92 to Industrial Boulevard.

Details of the closures are as follows:

- **Traffic from the Industrial Boulevard on-ramp closure will be detoured to Hesperian Boulevard and then onto westbound SR-92 to Industrial Boulevard**

Advance warning changeable message signs, detour signs and construction crew flaggers will be in place to assist motorists traveling in the area. This work is weather dependent and will be rescheduled if necessary. Motorists are advised to expect delays and allow extra time for their commute. Please drive with caution through the construction zone, leave a safe traveling distance between your vehicle and the vehicle ahead of you, and Slow for the Cone Zone.

California Highway Patrol will be on site during night closures.
