U.S. State Route 1 – Removing and Replacing Asphalt (Concrete Surfacing) Post Mile 3.3 to Post Mile 21.5

San Mateo County- The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin two projects to perform dig-outs and remove and replace failed asphalt on State Route 1 (SR 1) in San Mateo County from post mile 3.3 to 21.5. from 0.1 mile south of Bean Hollow Road to 0.5 mile north of Tunitas Creek Road, and from 1.4 miles north of Green Oaks Way to 0.1 mile south of Bean Hollow Road near Half Moon Bay on Monday, July 11, and will continue until the first week of October. This work will take place in the north & southbound directions on (SR 1) and include various locations.

Striping and installation of rumble strips will follow after asphalt work is completed.

One-way traffic control with flaggers will be in effect, Monday through Friday from 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM. One lane will remain open to traffic between construction hours. Changeable message signs are in place to help guide motorist through the construction zone.

Construction signs will be posted prior to construction to warn motorist of the upcoming project.

The new asphalt will improve the ride of the existing pavement and extend its service life.

NOTE: *At the beginning of the shift, residents may notice increased noise from grinding/paving equipment and mandatory backup alarms while the contractor is working in the construction zone.*
