**U.S.101 San Jose
Paving Project
Overnight Lane Closures
*Starts week of, May 20, 2018***

SANTA CLARA COUNTY– The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will perform pave the gore area on U.S.101, at various locations between Blossom Hill Road and West Trimble Road, in the City of San Jose. Construction is scheduled to begin May 20, and continue through Summer 2018.

Work hours:
Sunday-Thursday from 10:00 PM until 5:00 AM
With overnight alternating lane closures

During this work, residents may notice increased temporary construction noise. Motorist may experience delays as crews work to pave the gore area along U.S.-101 with intermittent overnight alternating lane closures. Advanced warning changeable message signs will be in place to assist motorist. All work is weather permitting.

Please drive cautiously through the construction zone, leave a safe traveling distance between your vehicle and the vehicle ahead of you, and please #BeWorkZoneAlert.
