Traffic Advisory: SR 237 Lane Closures
EFFECTIVE October 7 through October 10, 2018

The following freeway closure will be in effect as indicated, weather and conditions permitting.

SR 237 Express Lanes Project Construction	
LOCATION	Sunnyvale, CA
SITE	SR 237 between US 101 and Mathilda Avenue
WHAT	Eastbound SR 237 will be closed from US 101 to Mathilda Avenue.
DATE/TIME	Sunday, October 7, 2018 through Wednesday, October 10, 2018; 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. daily
ACTIVITY	Construction for overhead express lanes signage
DETOUR	Traffic will be detoured to US 101 southbound, exit at Fair Oaks Avenue eastbound, to US 101 northbound, exit at Mathilda Avenue northbound, to eastbound SR 237.

There will be safety signage at the work site. For the safety of the public and work crews, motorists are advised to slow for the cone zone - pay attention to detour signs and drive safely.

SR 237 Express Lanes Project

The Santa Clara Valley Transportation Authority (VTA) SR 237 Express Lanes Phase 2 Project is converting the existing High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV or carpool) lanes on State Route (SR) 237 to approximately Mathilda Avenue into express lanes to maximize existing capacity in carpool lanes.
