State Route 160-Three Mile Slough Bridge Drawbridge Open to Vehicular Motorists Closed to Boats Until Further Notice

SACRAMENTO COUNTY – Caltrans will be performing emergency repairs to the lifting mechanism on the State Route 160 (SR-160) Three Mile Slough Bridge in Sacramento County. The Delta drawbridge is currently open to vehicular traffic. However, some intermittent closures for motorists of no more than 20 minutes at a time may occur.
