Overnight Freeway Closures Scheduled For U.S. Highway 101 in East Palo Alto

*Northbound U.S. 101 Closed, Monday, November 26, 11:30 PM – 5:00 AM
Southbound U.S. 101 Closed, Wednesday November 28, 11:30 PM – 5:00 AM*

SAN MATEO COUNTY – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has scheduled two overnight closures of one direction of Highway 101 in East Palo Alto between Embarcadero Road and University Avenue.

The closures will allow work crews to remove a temporary support structure, known as falsework, that was used for constructing a new pedestrian/bicycle overcrossing at Clarke Avenue. The bicycle/pedestrian overcrossing is being constructed by the City of East Palo Alto under Caltrans oversight.

The first overnight closure is scheduled for northbound U.S. Highway 101 on Monday, November 26, 2018 from 11:30 PM – 5:30 AM. Starting at 10:00 PM, workers will begin closing lanes as traffic allows until all lanes are closed at 11:30 PM. Southbound Highway 101 will remain open during this closure.

The second overnight closure is scheduled for southbound U.S. Highway 101 on Wednesday, November 28, 2018, from 11:30 PM - 5:00 AM. Workers will begin closing lanes at 10:00 PM as traffic allows until all lanes are closed at 11:30 PM. Northbound U.S. Highway 101 will remain open during this closure.

Detours:

Northbound Highway 101: Exit at Embarcadero Road eastbound, left on East Bayshore Road, which becomes Donahoe Street, which leads to the on-ramp to northbound U.S. Highway 101

Soundbound Highway 101: Exit at University Avenue, right on University Avenue, right on Donahoe Street, which becomes East Bayshore Road, right on Embarcadero Road to the southbound U.S. Highway 101 on-ramp.
