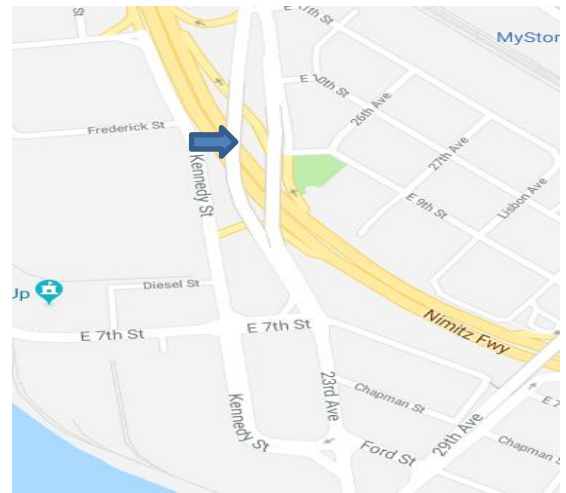

Interstate 880 Northbound at 23rd Avenue Off Ramp Closure Extended Until February 14, 2019

OAKLAND – Caltrans is conducting a full off ramp closure on Northbound (NB) Interstate 880 (I-880) at 23rd Avenue in Oakland, Alameda County to complete the soundwall between E. 9th and E. 10th Streets. The off ramp on I-880 at 23rd Avenue will reopen to traffic on February 14, 2019.

Detour Details:

- Use next available off ramps at Oak Street or 29th Avenue NB I-880

Closure Information

- **FULL CLOSURE:** NB I-880 at 23rd Avenue off ramp closed until February 14, 2019

Traffic Controls Measures:

Changeable message signs and directional signs will be in place to assist motorists traveling in the area. This work is weather dependent and will be rescheduled if necessary. Motorists are advised to expect delays and allow extra time for their commute.
