




Niles Canyon Safety Improvement Project

(Medium-Term Improvements)



Project Description:

Implement safety improvements at spot locations along the State Route 84 Corridor between State Route 238 (Mission Boulevard) and I-680.

Proposed scope of work may include:

- Construct improvements at low-speed curve
- Remove fixed objects including about 50 trees and 20 utility poles (*Clarification - This proposed improvement refers only to trees and poles within the 8-ft clear recovery zone.)
- Install two rockfall protection systems
- Widen shoulder at Paloma Way and Sims Park
- Replace bridge railing at Alameda Creek Bridge and Overhead
- Remove sidewalk and construct safety shaped barrier at Silver Springs Undercrossing
- Install signals at Pleasanton/Sunol Road and Main Street intersection
- Install speed feedback signs throughout the corridor
- Install dynamic warning system near Silver Springs Undercrossing and Palomares Road
- Install active warning system for bicyclists
- Replace Stonybrook box culvert with a clear span bridge
- Install temporary railing, lighting, and guardrails

Project Status:

Caltrans will be holding an environmental scoping meeting on October 14th, 2015 from 6-8 pm at the Sunol Glen Elementary School Cafeteria.

The purpose of the scoping meeting is to request input from public agencies, local governments, elected officials and the public on the scope of the environmental document.

A draft environmental document will be released for public comment in the fall of 2016.

- Issue Draft Environmental Document Fall 2016
- Final environmental document Early 2017
- Complete design Fall 2018
- Start construction Spring 2019
- Complete construction Spring 2021
