### **Full Overnight SB I-5 Closure Planned This Week; Paving Operations For SB I-5 Lanes**

**NORWALK** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) plans to close all southbound lanes of Interstate 5 between Rosecrans Avenue and Carmenita Road, on Thursday, May 19 from 1 a.m. to 4 a.m., and on Friday, May 20 from 1 a.m. to 6 a.m. as crews conduct paving operations.

Motorists will be directed to exit at Rosecrans Avenue to access the southbound Interstate 5 on-ramp at Valley View Avenue. Additionally, Caltrans plans to close the southbound Interstate 5 Rosecrans Avenue on-ramp and the southbound Carmenita Road off-ramp Monday, May 16 through Friday, May 20, from 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Please see the attached detour map.

The Santa Ana Freeway (I-5) high occupancy vehicle (HOV) / Rosecrans and Bloomfield Avenue Bridges Project extends from Shoemaker Avenue to Silverbow Avenue in the City of Norwalk. The project will widen one mile of I-5 to add one High Occupancy Vehicle Lane (also known as HOV or car pool lane) and one general purpose lane in each direction.
