### Overnight Lane Closures Planned for Caltrans Bridge Maintenance Project in Ventura County

VENTURA -- The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) advises drivers that a bridge maintenance project will require overnight lane closures on several highway bridges and ramps in Ventura County this week. The following closures are scheduled:

- **Ventura River Bridge on Southbound US Highway 101 in west Ventura:** Lane closure and closure of the ramp to Northbound Highway 33, between 9 p.m. tonight (Tuesday) and 6 a.m. Wednesday.
- **Vineyard Avenue Bridge over US 101 in Oxnard:** Lane closures with two-way traffic control and onramp closures between 11 p.m. Wednesday and 6 a.m. Thursday.
- **Southbound US 101 Bridge at Seacliff Exit in Rincon area:** Southbound lanes of US 101 will be closed at the Seacliff exit and southbound traffic will detour to Pacific Coast Highway (State Route 1) between 8 p.m. Thursday and 6 a.m. Friday.
- **Peck Road Bridge over Highway 126 in Santa Paula:** Lane closure with two-way traffic control between 7 p.m. Friday and 10 a.m. Saturday.
- **Lion Canyon Bridge over Old Highway 150 in Upper Ojai:** Lane closure with two-way traffic control between 7 p.m. Friday and 10 a.m. Saturday.

Truesdell Corp. of California, Inc., based in Tempe, Ariz., is the contractor on the \$1.5 million contract, which provides for preventive maintenance on bridge deck surfaces to extend their service life.

The project involves applying methacrylate resin to bridge decks, replacing joint seals and repairing some concrete surfaces.

Traffic control signs have been placed in affected areas. Caltrans reminds drivers to slow down and “**Be Work Zone Alert.**”
