


Caltrans District 9 Bicycle Guide

SR 120



Description:

SR 120 is a shared 2-lane conventional highway with narrow shoulders and is characterized by two distinct alignments with 5 miles of separation along US 395. The western alignment begins at Tioga Pass on the Tuolumne/Mono County line and intersects with US 395 just south of Lee Vining. It traverses down steep, winding grades which offer scenic views of Lee Vining Canyon. The eastern alignment begins at the US 395 junction just south of June Lake Loop's northern terminus and travels over the rolling hills of Mono Basin and the Benton Range before terminating at its junction with US 6 in Benton. SR 120 also provides connection for US 6 riders to US 395 via Benton Crossing Road, a popular county road for cyclists.
