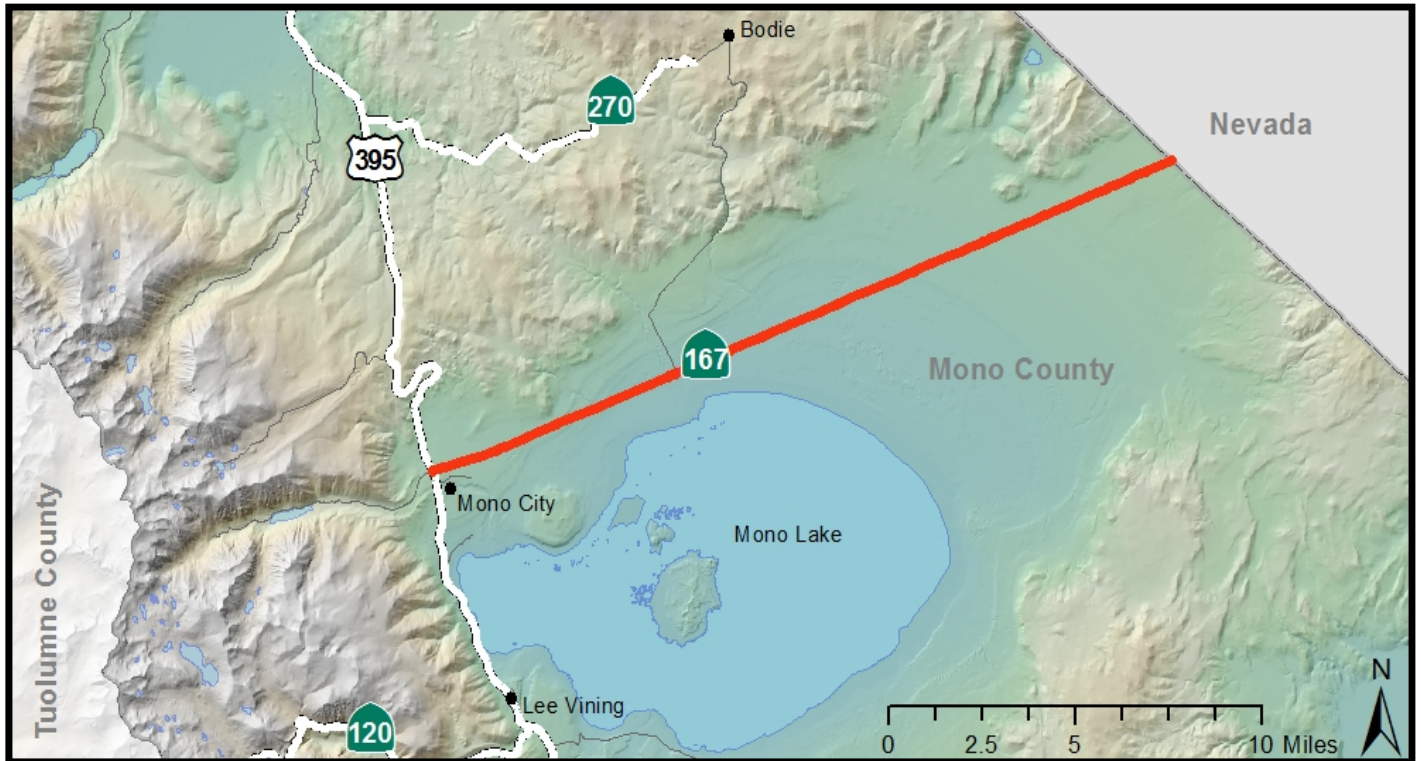


# Caltrans District 9 Bicycle Guide

## SR 167



### Description:

State Route 167 is a shared roadway and known as “Pole Line Road” that begins at its junction with US 395 and extends east to the California/Nevada state line. It is a straight, 2-lane conventional highway with narrow shoulders and gentle grades. Traffic is light and the highway travels through desert highlands with scenic views of Mono Lake to the south. SR 167 continues past the state border as Nevada Route 359.
