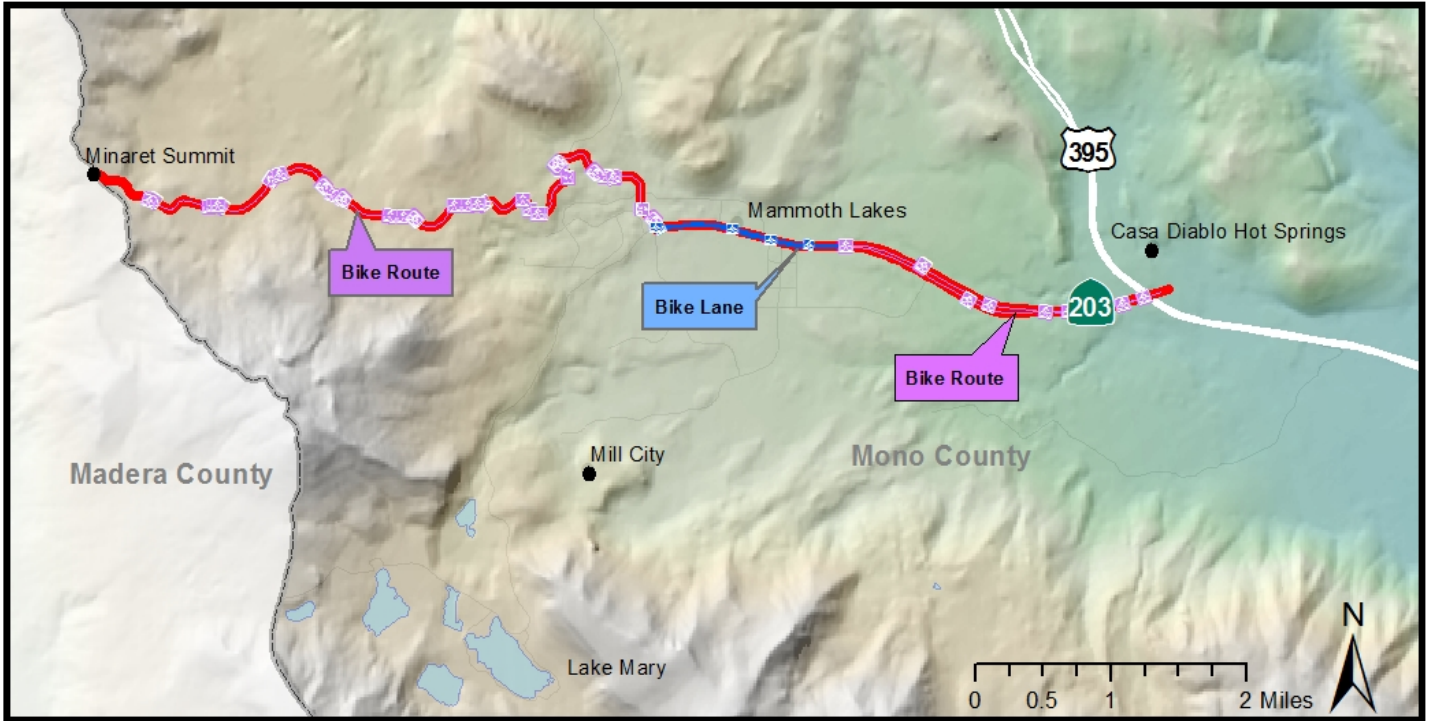


Caltrans District 9 Bicycle Guide

SR 203



Description:

SR 203 is a 2-lane conventional highway with narrow shoulders from the Madera/Mono County line to Lake Mary Road and a 4-lane highway with wide shoulders from Lake Mary Road to the US 395 junction. Traffic is moderate to heavy and seasonal, especially through the Town of Mammoth Lakes. SR 203 features moderate to steep grades with winding road geometry along the 2-lane segment and gentle grades along the 4-lane segment. SR 203 travels within an alpine climate susceptible to snow in the winter.

Note: SR 203 is a shared road way with a Class II facility (Bike Lane) on both sides from the Lake Mary/Minaret intersection to 0.05 mile east of the California Welcome Center. There are two Class III facilities (Bike Route) on both sides from 0.05 east of the Welcome Center to the end of the route; and 0.23 miles west of Mammoth Ski Area to Lake Mary Road.
