### High Point Curve Correction Project – Paving Operations

*Mono County* – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) would like to alert the traveling public of possible delays through the High Point Curve Correction Project near Topaz Lake. This is due to paving operations that are scheduled to begin on June 6<sup>th</sup> and last through June 14<sup>th</sup>. Travelers should expect to see flaggers located at the construction site 24 hours per day. Traffic will be allowed through the construction site by following a pilot car. The surface of the roadway will be unpaved until the paving operation is complete.

#### About the Project

The purpose of this project is to improve mobility and safety along .9 miles of US Highway 395 by realigning horizontal and vertical curves to increase speed and increasing the shoulder width from 2 to 8 feet. The location of the project is adjacent to Topaz Lake, between the highway's junction with State Route 89 and the California-Nevada border, post mile 118.7 to 119.6. This \$11 million project, should be complete by the end of July 2013. The contractor is Disney Construction, Inc of Burlingame, CA.

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***The traveling public is advised that 24 hours a day, there will be lane closures and flaggers with pilot cars guiding traffic. Anticipated delays are less than 20 minutes.***

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For the safety of the construction crew and motorists, please be attentive to closures, slow for the cone zone, and move over one lane where possible.

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
