U.S. HIGHWAY 101 NORTHBOUND ON-RAMP AT SOUTH HIGUERA STREET CLOSED IN SAN LUIS OBISPO FOR THE CITY TO THE SEA HALF MARATHON

SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY – Approximately two thousand runners participating in the City to the Sea Half Marathon will use portions of the state highway system on **Sunday, October 13**, between the hours of **7 am and 10 am** in the following locations:

- U.S. Hwy. 101 and South Higuera Street intersection.
- U.S. Hwy. 101 overcrossing at San Luis Bay Drive.
- U.S. Hwy. 101 overcrossing at Avila Beach Drive.

In addition, the U.S. Hwy. 101 **northbound on-ramp at South Higuera Street** will be **closed**.

There will **not** be any road closures resulting from this event, but motorists should use caution when runners are present. Law enforcement will be present to ensure the safety of race participants and motorists.
