PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD BEGINS FOR SANTA MARGARITA CREEK BANK STABILIZATION PROJECT NEAR U.S. HIGHWAY 101

SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY – The public may comment on a proposed creek bank stabilization project near U.S. Highway 101 in Santa Margarita from Monday, August 11 until Thursday, September 11. The public may review the Initial Study with a Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration at the following locations:
