ELEPHANT TRUNK PROJECT CONTINUES WITH DAYTIME WORK ONLY—NO MORE OVERNIGHT CLOSURES FOR NOW ON HIGHWAY 1 NEAR THE SAN LUIS OBISPO/MONTEREY COUNTY LINE

SAN LUIS OBISPO/MONTEREY COUNTIES – A project to construct a retaining wall on Highway 1 in northern San Luis Obispo/southern Monterey County (SLO PM 73.7-PM 74) is underway. It will serve as a permanent restoration effort in this area known for major slides.

Daytime roadwork continues Monday through Friday from 7 am to 5 pm. Construction this week includes the contractor working to place barrier rail. All local businesses along the coast will remain open during this project.

Motorists will encounter one-way reversing traffic control via a temporary traffic signal 24/7 except during overnight full closures. Traffic delays during the one-way traffic control will be 5-10 minutes.

The contractor for this \$9.5 million project is John Madonna Construction of San Luis Obispo, CA. This project is expected to be completed in winter 2016-17.

HIGHWAY 1/COW CLIFFS VIADUCT PROJECT CONTINUES—ONE FULL NIGHT CLOSURE TOMORROW, TUESDAY, AUGUST 9

MONTEREY COUNTY – A mostly daytime ½-mile project to construct a viaduct continues along Hwy. 1 near Lucia from the Big Creek Bridge to south of Dolan Creek Bridge (PM 31), near Big Creek Bridge (PM 28), about 18 miles south of Big Sur.

Roadwork for next week will require **a one-night overnight full closure** to set the girders on the northbound side of the viaduct tomorrow, **Tuesday, Aug. 9 from 10 pm to 6 am Wednesday, Aug. 10**. For the rest of the week there will be 10-minute traffic holds as needed. Hwy. 1 at Cow Cliffs will continue with one-way signalized traffic control 24/7.

The project consists of constructing a permanent viaduct, about five miles north of Lucia and 18 miles south of Big Sur. Daily roadwork schedules are subject to change due to weather conditions and other factors so stay tuned for weekly updates. **ALL BUSINESSES ALONG THE BIG SUR COAST WILL REMAIN OPEN.**

NOTE: This one-night full closure has been coordinated with Cal Fire and will not affect the Soberanes fire-fighting efforts.

The contractor for this \$3.9 million project is RGW Construction Inc. of Livermore, CA. Completion is scheduled for fall of 2016, weather permitting.
