## **ONE-DAY CHIP SEAL OPERATION ON HIGHWAY 183 BETWEEN SALINAS AND CASTROVILLE CONTINUES TOMORROW**

MONTEREY COUNTY –A two-day chip seal project along a two-mile section Hwy. 183 from north of San Jon Rd. to south of Espinosa Slough Bridge, between Salinas and Castroville continues tomorrow, Thursday, Oct. 22. Details are as follows:

- Both directions of Hwy. 183 from north of San Jon Rd. to south of Espinosa Slough Bridge
- Thursday, Oct. 22, from 9 am to 3 pm
- Traffic control consists of one-way reversing traffic control with pilot car.
- 15-20 minute delays are anticipated.

**NOTE: CHP will be present to assist with the detour and traffic control.**

Roadwork is being performed by the Caltrans Salinas Maintenance crew as a safety precaution to provide motorists and bicyclists a safer route to travel.

**Caltrans reminds motorists to move over and slow down when driving through highway work zones.**
