U.S. HIGHWAY 101 DRAINAGE AND SLIDE REPAIR IN PRUNEDALE NEXT WEEK

MONTEREY COUNTY –A three-day drainage and slide repair maintenance project at three separate locations on U.S. Highway 101 in Prunedale will take place starting next Tuesday, Feb. 23, Caltrans officials have announced. Details are as follows:

Tuesday, Feb. 23, drainage repair from 9 am to 3 pm:

- **Southbound** Hwy. 101 at San Miguel Cyn. Rd
- #3 (right, merge lane) from ramp closed
- 15-minute delays anticipated

Wednesday, Feb. 24, slide repair from 9 am to 2 pm:

- **Northbound** Hwy. 101 near Tustin Rd.
- #2 (right) lane closure
- 15-minute delays anticipated

Thursday, Feb. 25, slide repair from 9 am to 2 pm:

- **Northbound** Hwy. 101 near Dunbarton Rd.
- #2 (right) lane closure
- 15-minute delays anticipated

NOTE: There will be Electronic Message Boards alerting motorists, who can expect delays not to exceed 15 minutes.

The purpose of this project is to provide motorists and bicyclists a safer route to travel. Both the drainage issues and slides are due to the recent rains, needing urgent repair. Roadwork is expected to be complete by Thursday, Feb. 25, weather permitting.

This roadwork is being performed by Salinas North maintenance crew.

Caltrans reminds motorists to move over and slow down when driving through highway work zones.
