U.S. HIGHWAY 101 GUARDRAIL REPAIR IN PRUNEDALE ON SATURDAY

MONTEREY COUNTY –A one-day, maintenance project to repair a damaged guardrail along both directions of U.S. Highway 101 at Blackie Road/Reese Circle in Prunedale will take place on Saturday, Sept. 10, Caltrans officials have announced.

Details are as follows:

Southbound Hwy. 101 at Blackie/Reese Circle

- Acceleration/exit lane closed from 6 am to noon.
- Detour to Sala Road.

Northbound Hwy. 101 at Reese Circle

- Acceleration/exit lane closed from noon to 3 pm.
- Detour to Hwy. 156.

NOTE: There will be Electronic Message Boards alerting motorists, who can expect delays of up to 15 minutes. The CHP will be assisting with traffic control.

The purpose of this roadwork is to provide motorists and bicyclists a safer route to travel. The guardrail was hit and damaged recently, needing repair. It is scheduled to be completed the same day, Saturday, Sept. 10.

This roadwork is being performed by Salinas North Maintenance crew.

Caltrans reminds motorists to move over and slow down when driving through highway work zones.
