NORTHBOUND U.S. HIGHWAY 101 PAVING NEAR PRUNEDALE NEXT TUESDAY

MONTEREY COUNTY – A three-day, grind and pave operation requiring a lane closure along a one-mile section of **northbound** U.S. Highway 101 between Berta Canyon Rd. and San Miguel Canyon Rd. near Prunedale will begin on Tuesday, May 3, Caltrans officials have announced.

Roadwork is scheduled from 9 am to 1 pm each day Tuesday until Thursday and consists of a lane closure of the #2 (right) lane.

NOTE: There will be an Electronic Message Board alerting motorists, who can expect delays between 15-20 minutes. The CHP will be present to assist with traffic control.

The purpose of this project is to provide motorists and bicyclists a safer route to travel and better rideability. Roadwork is scheduled to be complete by Thursday, May 5.

This roadwork is being performed by Salinas North maintenance crew.

Caltrans reminds motorists to move over and slow down when driving through highway work zones.
