U.S. HIGHWAY 101 OVERNIGHT PAVING NEAR PRUNEDALE NEXT TWO WEEKS

MONTEREY COUNTY –A two-mile, overnight paving project on **both northbound and southbound** U. S. Highway 101 between Blackie Road and Tustin Road near Prunedale will begin Sunday night, Oct. 25, Caltrans officials have announced.

Roadwork is scheduled as follows:

SOUTHBOUND—Sunday, Oct. 25 through Thursday Oct. 30 (am)

Closure of the #2 (right) lane starting Sunday night, Oct. 25 at 8 pm. Overnight work hours are Sunday through Wednesday (Thurs. am) from 8 pm to 5 am each shift.

NORTHBOUND—Sunday, Nov. 1 through Thursday, Nov. 5 (am)

Closure of the #2 (right) lane starting Sunday night, Nov. 1 at 8 pm. Overnight work hours are Sunday through Wednesday (Thurs. am) from 8 pm to 5 am each shift.

NOTE: Electronic Message Boards will be posted alerting motorists, who can expect a delay not to exceed 15 minutes. The CHP will be assisting with safety and traffic control.

The purpose of this project is to provide motorists and bicyclists a safer route to travel. This project is expected to complete by Thursday morning, Nov. 5, weather permitting.

This roadwork is being performed by Salinas north Maintenance Crews.

Caltrans reminds motorists to move over and slow down when driving through highway work zones.
