PERMIT POTHOLING FOR UTILITY WORK AT VARIOUS LOCATIONS ALONG HIGHWAY 1 IN CARMEL STARTING NEXT WEEK

MONTEREY COUNTY –A permit project to pothole utility locations and elevations at about 14 sites between Oliver Dr. and Rio Rd. on Highway in Carmel will begin next Monday, March 7, weather permitting, Caltrans officials have announced.

Roadwork consists of shoulder closures and lane closures with one-way reversing traffic control with flagging. Work hours are Monday through Thursday from 9 am to 3 pm and Friday from 9 am to 12 noon. 5-10 minute traffic delays are anticipated. Work is scheduled to be complete by April 4, weather permitting.

NOTE: There will be Electronic Message Boards alerting motorists of closures.

This roadwork is being performed under permit by Granite Rock Construction of Watsonville, CA.

Caltrans reminds motorists to move over and slow down when driving through highway work zones.
