HIGHWAY 25 GRINDING AND PAVING BEGINS IN HOLLISTER MONDAY

SAN BENITO COUNTY – Crews will begin a week-long grinding and paving operation in both directions on Hwy. 25 through Hollister at various locations including Fourth and San Benito Streets next Monday, March 21, Caltrans officials have announced.

Roadwork will consist of alternating closures of the #1 (fast) lane throughout the one-mile stretch and one-way flagging at Fourth and San Benito Streets. Work hours for the week will be from 9 am to 3 pm. Up to 5-minute delays are anticipated.

All roadwork is being performed by our maintenance crews, which is expected to be completed by Friday afternoon, March 25, weather permitting.
