## HIGHWAY 1 PAVEMENT MARKER REPLACEMENT BETWEEN CAMBRIA AND CAYUCOS NEXT WEEK

**SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY** – A minor project to replace damaged or missing pavement markers on the highway will take place for one week on Hwy. 1 from Cambria to Cayucos, starting next Monday, Aug. 5.

Roadwork at this location consists of one-way reversing traffic control with a pilot car. Work hours for the week are from 8:30 am to 4 pm Monday, Aug. 5 through Thursday, Aug. 8 and from 8:30 am to 2 pm on Friday, Aug. 9, when work project completion is scheduled. 10-15 minute delays can be anticipated.

Part of this project also included replacing pavement markers on U. S. Highway 101 between Buellton and Goleta, which is taking place as well.

The contractor for this \$149,000 project is Sterndahl from Sun Valley, CA.
