## U.S. HIGHWAY 101 RESURFACING OF CUESTA GRADE CONTINUES NEXT WEEK

SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY – A project to resurface U.S. Highway 101 in both directions from Reservoir Canyon Road to north of Cuesta Peak will continue for the next two weeks beginning Sunday, Aug. 9 with road work scheduled during the daytime and overnight hours.

Motorists will encounter lane closures on **northbound** US Highway 101 Sunday night through through Friday morning from **8 pm until 9 am** and **southbound** from **7 pm until 6 am**. One lane will remain open to traffic in both directions along the two-lane segment of the highway while two lanes will remain open along the three-lane segment of the highway.

There will be daytime lane closures on northbound US Highway 101 next week from **9 am until 8 pm** and southbound from **6 am to 7 pm**. There will be no road work Fridays from 6 am until Sundays at 8 pm.

The contractor for this \$3.1 million project is Telfer Highway Technologies of McClellan, CA. This project is expected to be completed next month.
