HIGHWAY 1 RUMBLE STRIP PROJECT IN CAMBRIA RESUMES THIS MONTH

SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY – A safety project to install rumble strips along a 42-mile section of Highway 1 from Highland Drive in San Luis Obispo to one-mile north of Hearst Castle Road in San Simeon will resume in the Cambria area for 1-2 weeks beginning Monday, August 29.

Motorists will encounter one-way reversing traffic control with flaggers from Burton Drive to just south of Cambria Drive for two days the week of August 29 from 8 am until 4 pm. and for three additional days during the week of Sept. 6 from 8 am until 4 pm.

Delays are not expected to exceed 15 minutes. Electronic message signs will alert travelers about this roadwork.

The rumble strips recently installed this summer within this curved, nearly one-mile section of Highway 1 will be moved one-foot into the shoulder to minimize noise impacts that residents hear when vehicles drift onto them. This vibration has been amplified towards residents living near the roadway

The contractor for this \$1.6 million project which will enhance safety for the traveling public is Souza Construction of San Luis Obispo, CA. Completion is expected by the end of this month.


