US HIGHWAY 101 SURFACE TREATMENTS CONTINUE IN TEMPLETON NEXT WEEK

SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY – A project to install surface treatments near the on/off ramps of US Highway 101 in both directions from Curbaril Avenue to south of Monterey Road will continue next week in Templeton.

Motorists will encounter intermittent full on/off ramp closures in both directions of US Highway 101 at Las Tablas Road for a two to three week period weekdays beginning Monday, Sept. 12 from 8:30 am until 3 pm.

Access to these on/off ramps will be maintained for emergency vehicles at all times.

Motorists can expect delays not to exceed ten minutes. The contractor for this \$2.3 million project is Souza Construction of San Luis Obispo, CA. It is scheduled to be complete in January 2017, weather permitting.

Caltrans reminds motorists to move over and slow down when driving through highway construction zones.
