UPGRADES TO VEHICLE AND PEDESTRIAN SIGNALS BEGINS NEXT WEEK

SAN LUIS OBISPO/SANTA BARBARA COUNTIES – A project to upgrade vehicle and pedestrian signals will begin on Monday, October 17. The traffic signals will not be in operation from 7 am until 4 pm in the following locations:

- State Route 246/12th Street in Lompoc on Monday, Oct. 17 through Wednesday, Oct. 19.
- US Highway 101/Grand Avenue in Arroyo Grande on Wednesday, Oct. 19 through Friday, Oct. 21.
- State Route 227/Tolosa Place in SLO County on Friday, Oct. 21 and Thursday, Oct. 27.
- State Route 246/H Street in Lompoc on Monday October 24 through Wednesday, October 26.
- US Highway 101/Grand Avenue in Arroyo Grande on Monday, Oct. 31 through Friday, Nov. 4.

Motorists can expect delays not to exceed ten minutes. The contractor for this \$102,000 project is the Lee Wilson Electric Company of Arroyo Grande, CA. It is scheduled to be completed next month, weather permitting.
