ATASCADERO PAVING PROJECT INCLUDES FULL OVERNIGHT CLOSURES NEXT WEEK

ATASCADERO - The Hwy. 101 Atascadero Rehabilitation Project will continue with a full **overnight closure** on northbound Hwy. 101 near the Hwy 41 Interchange for **three nights: Monday, July 11, Wednesday, July 13 and Thursday, July 14 from 10 pm to 5 am each night** for concrete slab replacement.

Motorists headed northbound may exit Hwy. 101 at Hwy. 41 before continuing to the northbound Hwy. 101 on-ramp at Rosario Road. Detour signs will be onsite to assist motorists.

Motorists can expect delays not to exceed ten minutes.

This project includes repaving 11 miles of Hwy. 101 from north of the Cuesta Grade to Traffic Way. Caltrans will also widen bridges at Santa Margarita Creek, Atascadero Creek and Traffic Way and resurface the on and off-ramps at Santa Margarita, San Diego Road, Santa Rosa Road, Curbaril Avenue, Highway 41 and Traffic Way.

The contractor for this \$25.3 million project is Papich Construction of Pismo Beach, CA. This project is expected to be complete in the spring of 2012.

Caltrans reminds motorists to move over and slow down when driving through Caltrans construction zones.
