HIGHWAY 41 ROADWORK BEGINS NEXT WEEK

ATASCADERO – A two day project to maintain the pavement on Hwy. 41 will begin next week at the following locations:

- One lane of Hwy. 41 will be closed from Los Altos Road to Bear Ridge Road on Wednesday, Sept. 12 from 9 am to 1 pm. Motorists will encounter one way reversing traffic control with a pilot car.
- One lane of Hwy. 41 will be closed from Bear Ridge Road to Ironwood Drive on Thursday, Sept. 13 from 9 am to 1 pm. Motorists will encounter one way reversing traffic control with a pilot car.

Motorists can expect a delay not to exceed 30 minutes. This project will be performed by Caltrans Maintenance crews. The CHP will be present to help ensure traffic safety and electronic message signs will be posted to advise motorists.

Caltrans reminds motorists to move over and slow down while driving through highway construction zones.
