UPCOMING RAMP CLOSURES ON U.S. HIGHWAY 101 AT CURBARIL AVENUE AND THE HIGHWAY 101/58 INTERCHANGE

ATASCADERO - The **southbound Hwy. 101 off-ramp** at Curbaril Avenue will be closed 24/7 for a two week period beginning Sunday night, June 2 at 7 pm for paving.

The **southbound Hwy. 101 on-ramp** and the **northbound Hwy. 101 on/off-ramps** at Curbaril Avenue are open but are subject to periodic daytime and overnight closures.

- The **northbound Hwy. 101 on-ramp** at State Route 58 in Santa Margarita will be closed 24/7 for up to two weeks beginning Sunday, June 9 at 7 pm for paving and ramp reconstruction.
- The **northbound Hwy. 101 off-ramp** at State Route 58 in Santa Margarita will be closed 24/7 for up to two weeks beginning Sunday, June 16 at 7 pm for paving and ramp reconstruction (see map below).


Motorists headed northbound are encouraged to use El Camino Real to Santa Barbara Road as an alternate route during this closure.

This roadwork is part of the Atascadero Rehabilitation project which includes the re-paving of 11 miles of Hwy. 101 from north of the Cuesta Grade to Traffic Way. The contractor for this \$25 million project is Papich Construction of Pismo Beach, CA. This project is now 85% complete and is expected to be completed in the fall of 2013.
