HIGHWAY 1 MAINTENANCE NEAR CUESTA COLLEGE NEXT WEEK

SAN LUIS OBISPO COUNTY – A two-day maintenance project to preserve approximately 2.5 miles of pavement on Hwy. 1 from Hollister Road/Cuesta College South Entrance and San Luisito Creek Road will begin on Tuesday, June 18.

Motorists can expect intermittent closures of the No. 2 (slow lane) and the inside/outside shoulders in both directions of Hwy. 1 from 9 am to 3 pm on Tuesday, June 18. The No. 1 (fast) lane and the inside shoulder will be closed on Wednesday, June 19 from 9 am to 3 pm.

There will be **no shoulder access for cyclists** headed southbound from the San Luisito Creek Bridge and for cyclists headed northbound from Education Drive for up to a two hour period. The California Highway Patrol (CHP) will be present to ensure the safety of highway workers and the public.

This roadwork is being performed by the Caltrans Maintenance crew from Cambria.

Caltrans reminds motorists to move over and slow down when driving through highway construction zones.
